## THE LYING IN STATE

WESTMINSTER HALL,  
1910.

17th May - 4 p.m. to 10 p.m.  
18th May - 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.  
19th May - 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.

A Member introducing Ladies into Westminster Hall must accompany them himself, and not introduce more than two Ladies at a time.

A Member should meet the Ladies, whom he proposes to introduce, at the Gate into Palace Yard, which is situated below the roadway of Bridge Street, Westminster; he should then conduct them, through the Star Chamber Court, and the Members' Entrance, into Westminster Hall, and pass out by the North Door.

Access for Carriages will be by the Embankment, whence Ladies will proceed, either by the Tunnel or by the Metropolitan Railway Station, to the Gate below the Roadway of Bridge Street, Westminster.

The Gates at the foot of the Clock Tower will be closed.
